Authorizer-approved Freedom of Information Law Policy

As per Bedford Stuyvesant New Beginnings Charter School Charter (BSNBCS) approved by the New York State Board of Regents on March 12th, 2018, BSNBCS's Authorizer-approved Freedom of Information Law Policy is below:

“In accordance with FERPA, parents will be allowed to inspect and review all of their student’s educational records maintained by BSNBCS. Upon receipt of such a request, BSNBCS will adhere to the requirements of the Freedom of Information Law. In any event, BSNBCS will comply with such a request for access within a reasonable period of time, but in no case more than 45 days after it has received the request.”

BSNBCS will comply with all obligations and requirements under FOIL, consistent with the law.
